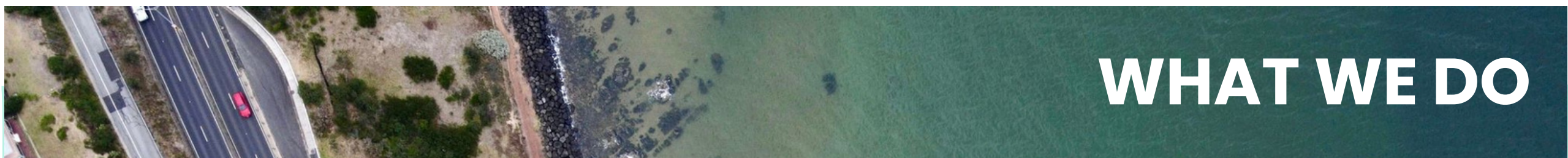


Influencing a better Peninsula.
